INSTALL AND MAINTENANCE MANUAL

4. Turn off electrical power before installing or servicing luminaire in any way.
5. To reduce the risk of fire and overheating, make sure all connections are tight.

WARNINGS AND CAUTIONS

- **Electrical Safety:** Disconnect power at the circuit breaker before installation or maintenance to avoid electric shock.
- **Qualified Personnel:** Installation must be performed by a licensed electrician in compliance with local codes.
- **Voltage Verification:** Ensure the supply voltage matches the fixture's specifications to prevent damage.
- **Secure Mounting:** Verify that the mounting surface or structure can support the weight of the fixture.
- **Wiring Precautions:** Ensure all wiring connections are properly insulated and secure to prevent hazards.
- **Heat Dissipation:** Ensure adequate clearance around the fixture to allow for proper heat dissipation and prevent overheating.
- **Environmental Conditions:** Suitable for both indoor and outdoor use. Ensure the installation environment is free of corrosive substances.
- **Avoid Exposure:** Do not install the fixture in areas prone to prolonged submersion or extreme environmental conditions unless specifically rated for such use.

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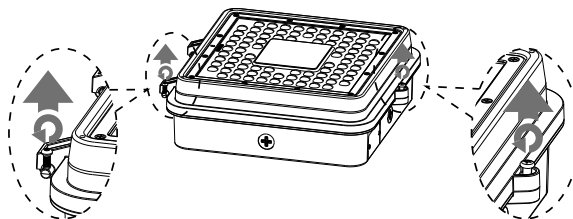
1. Ceiling Mounting
2. Conduit Pendant mounting

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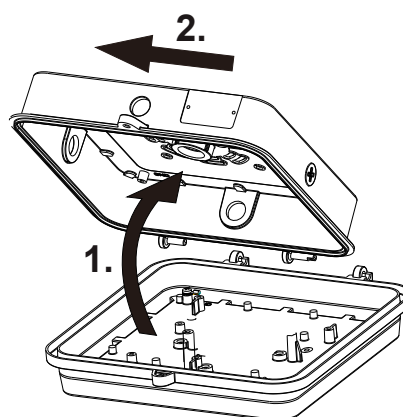
1 CEILING MOUNTING

- 1-1. Remove the screws securing the fixture lens to the fixture body.
- 1-2. Swing the fixture lens open and slide it off the fixture body.
- 1-3. Choose the appropriate mounting holes on the fixture body for attachment to the electrical mounting box, and drill or knock them out as needed.
- 1-4. Drill or knock out the four support points on the fixture body.
- 1-5. Drill matching holes in the ceiling and install suitable anchors.
- 1-6. Attach the gasket to the back of the fixture body.
- 1-7. Secure the fixture body to the ceiling and junction box.

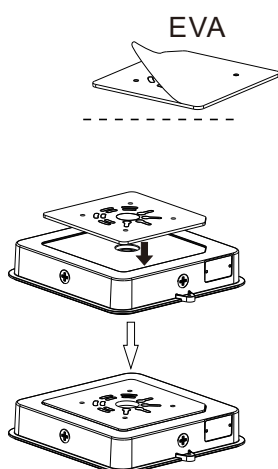
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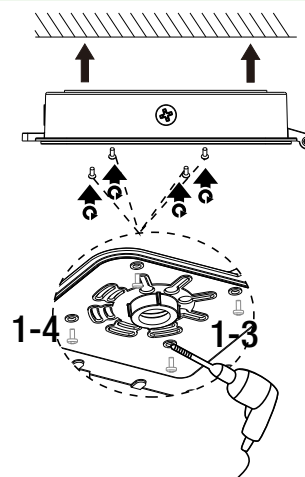
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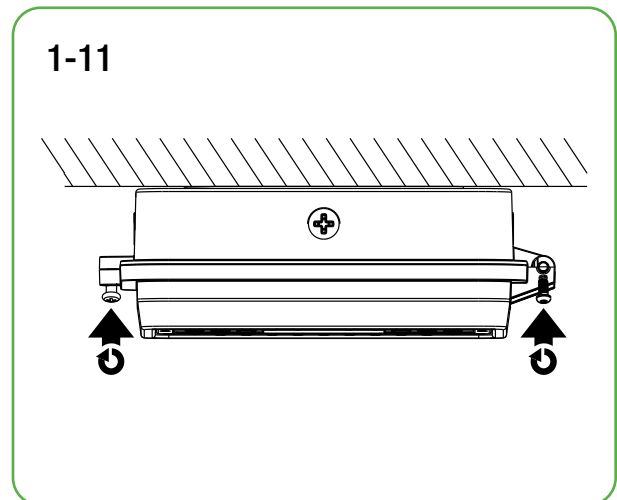
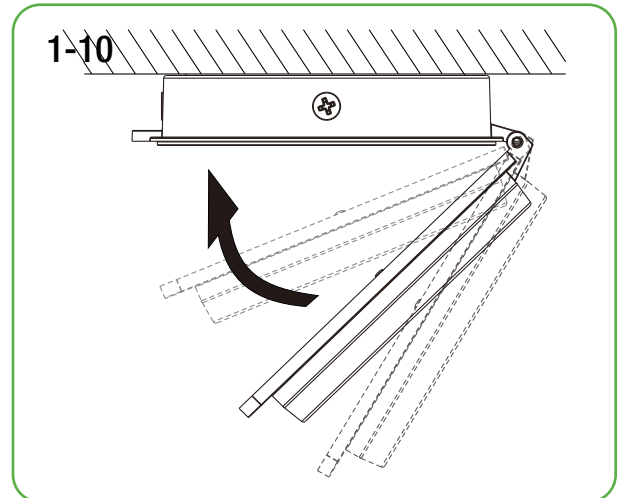
1-8. Connect the fixture wires as follows:

- **Black:** Live/Hot
- **White:** Neutral
- **Green:** Ground
- **Purple:** Dim+ (if applicable)
- **Pink:** Dim- (if applicable)

1-9. If not using dimming, individually cap the dimming wires with wire nuts or approved connectors.

1-10. Hinge the lens back onto the fixture body.

1-11. Swing the lens onto the fixture body and tighten the screws to secure it in place.

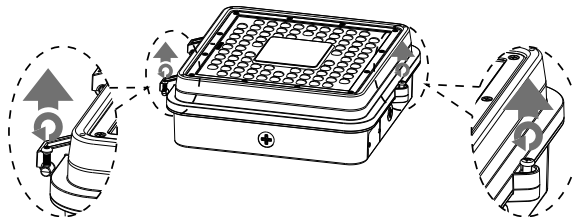


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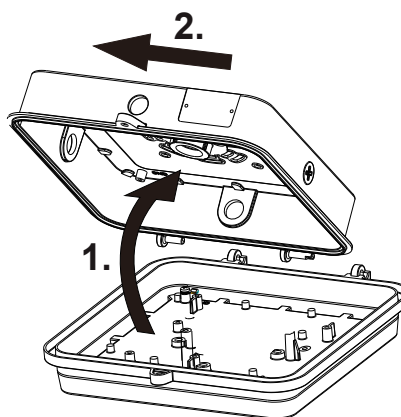
2 CONDUIT PENDANT MOUNTING

- 2-1. Remove the screws securing the fixture lens to the fixture body.
- 2-2. Swing the fixture lens open and slide it off the fixture body.
- 2-3. Place a suitable gasket on the conduit to ensure a proper seal.
- 2-4. Attach the fixture body securely to the conduit.
- 2-5. Connect the fixture wires as follows:
 - **Black:** Live/Hot
 - **White:** Neutral
 - **Green:** Ground
 - **Purple:** Dim+ (if applicable)
 - **Pink:** Dim- (if applicable)
- 2-6. If not using dimming, individually cap the dimming wires with wire nuts or approved connectors.

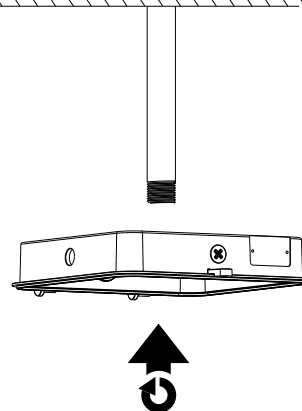

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2-7. Hinge the lens back onto the fixture body.

2-8. Swing the fixture body onto the fixture base and tighten the screws to secure it in place.
